Ken Elkinson (Link)

From California comes the music of Ken Elkinson (b. 1972), composer and pianist.

Since he was very little he had a passion for music, but also studied guitar and bass. At the age of twenty, he decided that his was the piano. A little later he founded August Son Productions to publicize his music, while he released his first CD, "Midnight Conversation" (1996). The critical and commercial success encouraged him to continue writing. In 2000 he published "Revelry," which reached the Top 20 in more than seventy radio stations in the United States and other countries.

Currently, and after eight CD's published, Ken Elkinson has achieved great popularity with their music intimate, introspective and sensitive. Sometimes minimal, sometimes complex, the themes are kept shelling melodies who can convey how the author perceives the world and moods. His short stories have themes in depth and easy to catch the listener from its opening stages.

Ken has just released its latest album, "Link." Twelve songs for piano, representative of his style. I propose that we hear three of them, each with its own personality, all very inspired.
